

Harp Retreat 2019

Wow – we have the most amazing harpist and teacher coming to work with us at Harp Retreat 2019 – Maeve Gilchrist!!! Maeve studied traditional Scottish harp and voice, then jazz studies ... is a teacher, composer/collaborator, performer and totally awesome person! But... she comes with a price – the tuition price is \$70 more than last year to accommodate this (based on getting 40 harpies involved). We're extremely lucky to have enticed her to Harp Retreat!

Maeve will also perform a mini concert for us on Saturday evening – included in the registration fee for students, but parents/families who want to attend the concert will need to pay \$10 per person (on the night).

I apologise – the costings table looks confusing!! There is one price for harpists and one for non-harpists, one price for those who pay the deposit before Dec 15th and one price for those who pay after Dec 15th. And there is one price for those who want cabin accommodation and a different one for those who choose dormitory accommodation.

Accom – that's where you sleep for two nights! either in the dormitories (up to 25 people) or small cabin (1, 2 or 3 people). There are a limited number of cabins and once they are booked, the remainder of people will share the dormitories, regardless of their preference. FYI - last year most of the cabins were booked before the early bird registration closed.

The discounted pricing is only available if the deposit (\$100) is paid prior to Dec 15th.

If you are under 16 years, BYO adult, or ... contact me to discuss. Unaccompanied teens/children will be sleeping in the dormitories, not in cabins. Unaccompanied teens/children have to be booked in the earlybird session, so we can make sure we have the right adult/child ratio sorted out. In the past, families/parents/kids have morphed so to be parent by proxy for someone else's child – please make sure I know if you are doing this ... it helps to keep me sorted with room allocation.

Food – Dinner Friday evening (it will be something re-heatable if you are late)
Breakfasts and lunches Saturday/Sunday, Saturday dinner
Snacks, and hot and cold drinks (no-one ever goes hungry!)

Tuition – This is for harpies only – we've got more interest from harpies than ever. Maeve, and I, and possibly one other teacher, will be offering workshops through the day for beginners and intermediate/advanced students, and there will be other workshops happening over the weekend also.
